Additionally, some students had access to Arte Organico classes with La Familia Sana. 2024-25 In the Spring of 2025 Secondary students attended the Oregon Shakespeare festival. The trip gave students direct exposure to live professional theater, allowing them to experience the power of Shakespeare's works and contemporary productions on stage. For many, it was their first time seeing a professional performance, sparking new appreciation for the arts and opening conversations about storytelling, history, and culture.
